SUBCOMMITTEE

- Responsible for recovery portion of every event leading up to the convention. (Doesn't always have to be a speaker)
- Main Speakers for Convention - 3 out of town & 1 local.
- Enlisted the help of others to find Workshop Speakers. They took the workshop line up to meetings & events to get people to sign up.

Workshops

- We chose to do 2 workshops at a time with dual topics. We had a great turn out for all the workshops.
- Copy of the line up is included.

Formats

- There are binders with formats in the locker
- Binders include formats for:
 - Workshops
 - Marathon Meeting
 - Main Speakers
- Copies of the readings are included. They can be used at events also
- The formats will need to be re-typed to match next year's theme/logo
- Rich M. has these files if wanted on his computer

Budget

- Asked for \$3000.00.
- Only used - approx \$775⁰⁰
- One speaker was reimbursed their airfare, 2 speakers insisted on taking care of their own travel, 1 round trip airfare purchased by committee.

NEWCOMER

- At Clean time countdown, Basic Texts are given to those with 30 days or less cleantime
- Chicagoland Region donated 10 soft cover
- Roughly 25-30 Basic Texts are in

the locker. There are also speaker CD's that were donated by Tape to Tape and are in the box with the books.

This year started rough as there was no programming material from prior conventions. We had a fellow addict give us a Thumb drive from ARCNA 35. We were able to use our main speakers for Saturday from that. Other members helped get speaker CD's sent in.

More needs to be acquired and added to the programming supplies.

Our service consists of on-site audio taping and duplication of workshops and main speaker meetings on cassettes and compact discs.

Benjamin Lacey owner and operator will attend Convention and supervise all operations.

Contractor will provide audio taping of workshops on wireless audio voice recorders. The process will be downloaded then uploaded to compact disc.

Contractor pays for travel and hotel expenses. Contractor will make a financial contribution of \$150 or 20% from all audio sales

Contractor will offer each workshop/main speaker a complimentary tape/compact disc of his or her message. Contractor donates one complete set of convention compact discs for your archives to the host committee and additional 5 flash drives.

Contractor will return any defective tape or compact disc up to one year at the Contractor expense, unless there is a malfunction with the customer audio equipment. Therefore, the customer must incur the expense.

Contractor sets compact disc prices are \$6.00 per compact disc, \$30.00 per six and \$50.00 per twelve with full color logo on each compact disc.
